Purpose of the SSHS Tour:

To provoke dialogue on college campuses across the US between students and life-coaches, or sexperts as we may call them, in which we may discuss the answers to:

- Why can't I keep a man? I really don't want to have sex with him but if I want to keep him, I have to!
- Why do I keep choosing losers? Will I ever get married?

Underneath the rampage of sexual activities, dialogue of the following issues may also be addressed:

- Prostitution: What's wrong with having a selection? The more the better, as long as I don't let my right hand know what my left one is doing!
- Homosexuality: What do you do when your risky sexual relationships have caught up with you?
- Masturbation: What do you do when the relationships don't satisfy you and your lovers continue to fail you?

Background Information - Making Sense of Sex:

There are many factors that can contribute to someone feeling unsure about the decision to be sexually active. Decisions about sex can be influenced by our socialization as men and women. This socialization can make men feel as if they have to be the sexual aggressor and be ready and wanting of sex all of the time. Women can be made to feel as if it is shameful to have sexual appetites of their own although at the same time the media often portrays women as sexual objects.

The media, family, peers and other external influences can give us differing messages about our sexuality. All of these different messages can lead to confusion. "I did it because I chose to. I was abstinent 'til I was 24 just because there were all these things built up around sex that lead to a lot of pressure," says a New Mexico State University student. Seeking out information and talking with friends, family or counselors on campus can be helpful in sorting through these issues and in developing a good sense of your own sexual identity.

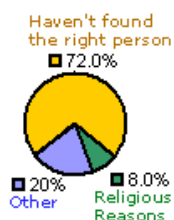
Shown below are sexual statistics taken from a collegiate campus survey:

Who is K.B. Jenkins?

Concerned with the 90+ million (and yet growing) singles in the United States, of which a large percentage are women—and the sincere longing of many to be wed; while acknowledging the pool of testosterone and incarcerated seed that floods our state prisons; same-sex relationships, divorce and "black on black crime" that covertly undermine Godly covenant and potential, minister, psalmist, and author, **K.B. Jenkins** provokes us to consider the culprit, and reconsider the nature of this often "expired and out-of-season status."

Reminded of her own temptations and triumphs, the author permits us behind the scenes of her book "*Now*," and leads us into her past where she introduces us to her former self as a girlfriend-wife" content with the counterfeit oneness of her "boyfriend-husband. This native of Newark, New Jersey has served as an associate minister and worship leader under the leadership of **Bishop Donald Hilliard, Jr.** for several years. A former "Profile Records" recording artist, K.B. has also graced the stage of several Off-Broadway productions ("**Mama I Want To Sing;**" "**Let the Music play Gospel;**" "**Zooman and the Sign,**" "**When Love Hurts**" and "**Stop the Funeral.**") K.B. is the founder of "**The King's Daughters Ministries**" and "**S.O.L.O. 4 Christ,**" where she is devoted to spreading the Love, Truth and Power of Jesus Christ whether in word, song or through her publications. K.B. is "**S.O.L.O. Again**" and currently resides in Atlanta, GA.

Who is John Gray?



On June 26 1973, a destiny was born. God set into motion a plan that would take a young boy from Cincinnati, Ohio around the world and back to proclaim His glory to all who'd receive the message. This boy would be inevitably transformed into a man of God through many trials and triumphs. **John W. Gray III**, was ordained with a voice that would become the tool of his testimony; his vision, **MANNAGOD Enterprises**, the vehicle to victory.

Gray started early on his path. He began singing in, and directing the choir at Bethel Baptist Church in Cincinnati at seven years old, while later winning many Shakespeare and chorus competitions in high school. Upon entering college, he furthered his training by playing the lead role in the stage play, *The Boys Next Door*, singing in the gospel choir and the African American Cultural and Research Center Choir at the University of Cincinnati.

Opportunity pounded on Gray's door in 1995 when he left Cincinnati to become a cast member in the critically acclaimed gospel play, "**He Say, She Say, But What Does God Say?**" starring Grammy award-winning artists, **Kirk Franklin and the Family**. After completing the successful tour, Gray was asked to permanently become a member of Kirk Franklin and the Family, touring around the world with the group for three years. In addition to singing, Gray's acting ability was highlighted in 1998 when he guest starred on an episode of the top-rated television comedy, "**Sister, Sister.**"

Expanding upon his creative gifts, Gray toured with Christian rock group, *dc talk* and Grammy award-winning group **God's Property**, serving as Emcee, comedian, and worship leader as they promoted racial reconciliation around the country. Upon returning from the tour in 2000, Gray

relocated to New Jersey, and accepted a position as Youth Minister at the First Baptist Church of Lincoln Gardens in Somerset. In 2001, he became the Coordinator of Youth Ministries at The Cathedral International Church in Perth Amboy, NJ under the leadership of **Bishop Donald Hilliard, Jr.**

The urge to act compelled Gray back onto the stage in the fall of 2002 when he toured with the hit stage play, "**Lord, All Men Can't Be Dogs,**" starring **Regina Belle, Carvin Winans, and A.J. Johnson.** It was after that tour that Gray was led to reveal his own vision, **MANNAGOD, Inc.**

John W. Gray III is an anointed man of God guided by the almighty *MANNAGOD* and seeking to be a light in the world by bringing souls to Christ. It is truly time for his vision.
